Must take 1 each semester to maintain enrollment at NC.</p> <p><u>Norco College Guidelines:</u> 3-8 Units Fall/Spring 5 Units max Summer/Winter 11 Units for overload* students (Over 3.0 and 10 units completed)</p> <p>Take the AccuPlacer test at Norco College <i>if needed</i> for English, Science, Math and Foreign Language classes. This option is for students on an Associate's Degree pathway or applying for Norco College Honors Program.</p> <p>With approval, students following the STEM educational plan may take Norco College Math or Science in place of High School Math or Science</p> <p>Students taking History and English classes at Norco College will take them in conjunction with High school US History and LA 3 A/B. Norco College classes cannot be taken in place of graduation courses.</p> <p><u>11th grade Class Suggestions:</u> Students will have numerous Norco College classes available to them and are expected to take classes that will align with their college and career goals.</p> <p>Take Health Science</p> <p>Foreign Language information: SPA 1, JPN 1, FRE 1 equivalent to California high school year 1 and 2 A-G Span 2, JPN 2, FRE 2 equivalent to California high school year 3 A-G</p> <p><small>*Overload is Norco College approval to take up to 11 units in one semester.</small></p>
